OUTSIDE BREAN SPLASH WATERPARK:



I MIGHT SEE:

- Cars or lorries driving past
- A big building with waterslides coming out of it
- A building called Brean Play
- The rides at Brean Theme Park
- Seagulls flying around
- Lots of people walking about
- Cars in the car park



OUTSIDE BREAN SPLASH WATERPARK:




I MIGHT HEAR:

- Cars and lorries going past on the road.
- Seagulls making a noise
- The wind blowing
- People or children talking, shouting or laughing
- Noises from the rides at the Theme Park



I MIGHT TOUCH:

- Concrete
- Glass
- Bricks
- Tarmac
- The wind, sun or rain



OUTSIDE BREAN SPLASH WATERPARK:



I MIGHT SMELL:

- Fumes from the cars and lorries driving past
- Food cooking in the nearby restaurants

INSIDE THE ENTRANCE TO BREAN SPLASH WATERPARK:

- I or the person with me buys a ticket from Reception
- A lot of people like to visit Brean Splash Waterpark so sometimes there might be a queue and I might need to wait
- If I need anything or I am unable to queue, I can enter through the gym entrance door to speak to a team member



INSIDE THE ENTRANCE TO BREAN SPLASH WATERPARK:



I MIGHT SEE:

- Lots of people, some wearing special Brean Splash clothes
- Lots of signs with words and pictures on
- T.V screens showing pictures and videos
- Tables and chairs
- A shop
- A queue waiting to enter



I MIGHT HEAR:

- People talking
- Music playing
- The sound of a coffee machine making drinks
- The phone ringing

INSIDE THE ENTRANCE TO BREAN SPLASH WATERPARK:



I MIGHT TOUCH:

- Carpet
- Wood
- Other people brushing past me



I MIGHT SMELL:

- Food or drink from the Brean Splash Café



I MIGHT TASTE:

- Food or drink from the Brean Splash Café



INSIDE THE ENTRANCE TO BREAN SPLASH WATERPARK:

- I will be given a band to put on my wrist like this:



- If I don't want to wear it whoever is with me can wear it for me
- Before I go into the water I need to get changed into my swimsuit or swimming trunks
- There are changing rooms where I can do this
- Before I go in the pools and on the slides I need to have a shower in a poolside shower
- This helps to keep the water in the Waterpark clean for everyone

INSIDE BREAN SPLASH WATERPARK:



I MIGHT SEE:

- People in and out of the water having fun
- Slides and people queuing to go on them
- People sliding down the slides into the water
- People walking or sitting on the pool side
- Lifeguards in yellow shirts who help keep everyone safe



INSIDE BREAN SPLASH WATERPARK:



I MIGHT HEAR:

- Music
- A man or lady talking on the tannoy
- People talking, shouting, shrieking or laughing
- Water splashing
- The Lifeguards blowing their whistles
- The fire alarm, which sounds like a loud siren.
If this happens, the person with me will
tell me what to do



INSIDE BREAN SPLASH WATERPARK:



I MIGHT TOUCH:

- Tiles or water underneath my bare feet, so I must walk and not run
- Water on my body and my head
- The band on my wrist if I am wearing one
- Goggles or arm bands if I am wearing them
- People pushing past me or standing next to me
- My swimsuit or trunks against my skin



INSIDE BREAN SPLASH WATERPARK:



I MIGHT TASTE:

- The pool water if I accidentally swallow some
- Drinks or food from the Café
- Water splashing in my face as i come down a water slide



I MIGHT SMELL:

- Chlorine that keeps the water clean



INSIDE BREAN SPLASH WATERPARK THERE ARE LOTS OF THINGS I CAN DO:

- I can paddle or swim in one of the pools
- I can go on the slides...
 - In any order I want to
 - Lots of times if I want to
 - Not at all if I don't want to
- Sometimes there are lots of steps up to the slides
- Sometimes lots of people might want to go on the slides and I might have to wait



INSIDE BREAN SPLASH WATERPARK THERE ARE LOTS OF THINGS I CAN DO:

- Sometimes I might have to be a certain age or height to go on the slides. Whoever is with me will help me with this
- I can get out of the water and use the toilet when I need to
- Brean Splash Waterpark can be noisy so I can wear ear defenders if I want to
- If I want to leave & I have only been in the waterpark for a short time (less than 30 minutes), I can come back for free on my next visit if the person I am with speaks to the Duty Manager to let them know before we leave



THE STEPS I MIGHT GO THROUGH WHEN I VISIT BREAN SPLASH WATERPARK ARE:

1

I arrive at Brean Splash Waterpark. There may be queue. If i am unable to queue i can enter through the gym entran door to speak to a team member.

2

Inside, I or the person who is with me buys a ticket

3

I get issued a session band

4

I go to the changing rooms, have a shower
And put on my swimming costume or trunks

5

I go in the pools and on the slides if I want to

6

I get out of the water and go to the toilet
when I need to

7

I eat some food when I am hungry

8

When I have finished in the waterpark I go to the changing rooms, have a shower, get dry and put my clothes on

9

It's time for me to leave, and I hand my session band in by putting it in the returns bin.
